Camp again will be at the NC FFA Camp at White Lake, NC from Monday through Friday, June 15th-19th, 2020.

This amazing week is at a member cost of only \$395 per teen to educate our future co-op leaders! A bus is included to pick up teens at designated locations across the state depending on where our teens are coming from for this year! We encourage our members to sponsor local teens for this program.

Cooperative Leadership Camp Member and Non-Member Sponsorships
